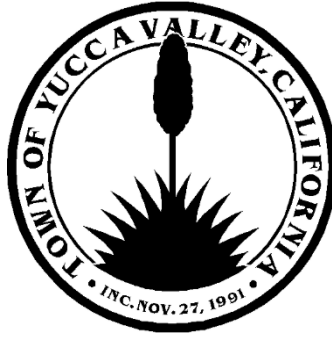

Rosie is a sweet, loving mama with a gentle heart. She's calm, caring, and always ready to give affection to those she trusts.



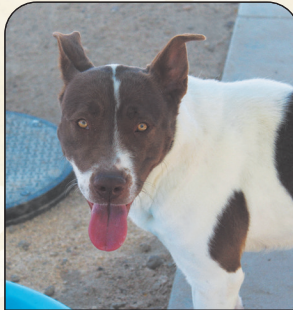
Lily Pad is a friendly and playful girl with a curious, adventurous spirit. She loves exploring new places, learning new things, and spending time with her people.
